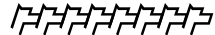

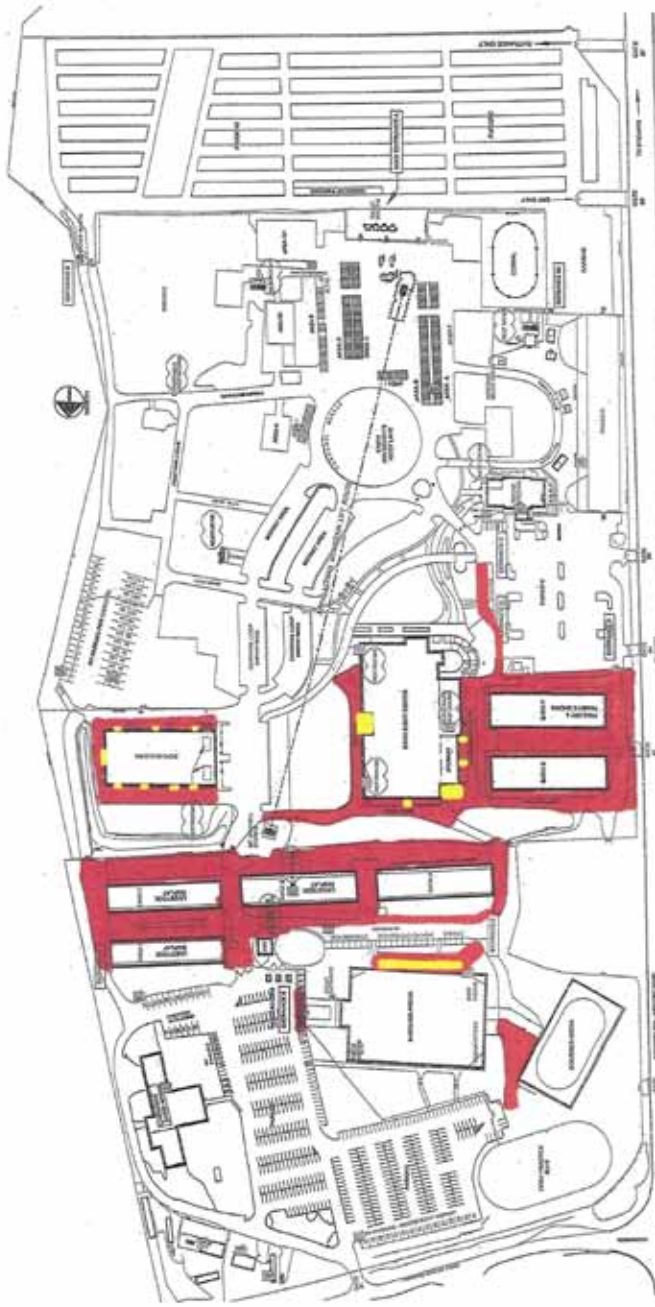

Exhibitor Parking

There will be **NO parking fees for the weekend. Enter Gate #5 SLOWLY!** There will be no permanent parking around the grooming areas and stalls. These areas will be for loading and unloading only with your emergency lights left on. Any vehicles parking in areas designated as Unloading Only or No Parking areas will be subject to fines towing without notice at the owner's expense. Do not park on landscaped areas around the facility.

Bathing Stations

There will be bathing stations available to bathe dogs. These will be located outside of the covered grooming area and close to the grooming tent between the Davis & Expo Buildings.
Please exercise care not to walk wet dogs inside the buildings.



Grooming Areas & Stall Rental

Enter Gate #5 for grooming areas.

There is **Free Grooming on concrete under permanent cover near Davis Building.** However space and electricity are limited. Also located between the Davis and Expo Buildings will be a large tent equipped with electric for grooming. Please be prepared to stack your crates. The Event Committee reserves the right to condense space if it should become necessary. Please leave aisles open. No private x-pens allowed in grooming area.

STALLS CAN BE RENTED FOR TOTAL OF 10 DAYS OF THE CLUSTER BUT 10 DAYS STALLS WILL BE GIVEN A DISCOUNT OR 5 DAYS FOR WEEK ONE OR 5 DAYS FOR WEEK TWO. THERE IS NO RENTAL FEE FOR TUESDAY, MAY 26, 2026

10 day rental of outer paved stalls \$102.00, inner stall rental \$68.00, outer unpaved stalls \$77.00, portable stalls \$85.00.

OUTER PAVED STALL RENTAL: The fee to rent a level paved OUTER stall for a five-day show circuit is \$60.00. These stalls have electrical access. Dogs may be left in the stalls overnight. You may bring your own locks and floor covering.

NOTE REGARDING STALL PARKING: By Orders of the Fire Marshal there will be **NO PARKING** at any of the Stalls!! You may unload and move your vehicle to a space in the parking lot. Vehicles may be towed if left by the stalls. No vehicle may be left unattended while loading or unloading.

INNER STALL RENTAL: There will be a limited number of inner stalls with electrical access available if needed with uneven hard clay flooring and dim lighting. Grooming may be done just outside of stalls. You are encouraged to bring your own ground cover and locks for the stalls. These stalls will be rented for \$40.00 for a five-day circuit.

As the Agricultural Center charges the Kennel Club for use of each stall, absolutely no one will be allowed to set up in the stalls or use electrical outlets in the stalls without paying the rental fee. The reserved grooming area will be policed for violations.

OUTER UNPAVED STALL RENTAL: These stalls have uneven hard clay floors. Grooming may be done under overhang outside of stalls. You are encouraged to bring ground cover and locks for your stalls. These stalls can be rented for \$45.00 for the five day circuit.

PORTABLE STALLS ON CONCRETE: These stalls will have electrical access and can be locked and they will be rented for \$50.00 for a five-day circuit.

All Stalls will have names on them.

Stalls will be available for Cluster I on Wednesday, May 20, 2026 at 12:00 Noon and on Tuesday, May 26, 2026 at noon for Cluster II unless previously arranged for special needs. Stalls are not available for daily rental. There will be **NO REFUNDS** after May 6, 2026 for Cluster I or May 13, 2026 for Cluster II. Please do not send reservations with checks after May 6, 2026 for Cluster I or May 13, 2026 for Cluster II until you have either called or E-mailed Lynnea for availability.

Building Access & Grooming Information

Cluster I - Exhibitors may enter Gate #5 at the show site from 12:00 Noon on Wednesday, May 20, 2026. All dogs and vehicles need to be removed from the Ag Center property by the end of the show on Monday, May 25, 2026 unless staying over Tuesday, May 26, 2026 to attend Cluster II starting on Wednesday, May 27, 2026.

Cluster II - Exhibitors may enter Gate #5 at the show site from 12:00 Noon on Tuesday, May 26, 2026. All dogs and vehicles need to be removed from the Ag Center property by the end of the show on Sunday, May 31, 2026.

Vendors may enter Gate #7.

Exhibitors and Vendors may enter Gate # 5 at 6:00 A.M. Daily.

Show Buildings will open at 7:00 A.M. Daily.

No bathing of dogs inside of bathroom shower facilities.

No space may be saved for others. Exhibitors must establish a grooming area no larger than the immediate needs for the number of dogs being exhibited. Excessive grooming areas may be reduced by the event committee. Stacking of crates may be required.

No dogs left unattended on grooming tables.

Exhibitors and handlers are responsible to maintain clean conditions in their grooming area. You must clean up after your dogs in outside areas. Clean and courteous behavior will help ensure future use of these facilities.

No private exercise pens are permitted inside the building, in front or around the building or in the grooming areas. **Strollers** will be used at the discretion and risk of the owner/operator. Please read the Club/Superintendent caution statement on page 22.

No crating in Building except ringside crating which is allowed 15 minutes before judging and must be removed 15 minutes after breed judging. Crates have to be in designated area and must be attended at all times except when the exhibitor is in the ring. No grooming is allowed ringside. Crates left at ringside when breed judging is over will be removed by the Event Committee.

Motels have been asked to notify us of any damages. The clubs will convene an Event Committee Hearing to deal with refusal to follow instructions, and we will recommend suspension for anyone found guilty of serious offenses.

Notice

All persons attending these dog show events hereby waive any claim for damage against the clubs or their members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation. The clubs, their members, superintendent, and facility employees will not be liable for loss or injury which may be sustained through the disappearance, theft, injury and/or death of dogs at these events.

Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received. **Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please verify your entry with the MB-F Office in North Carolina.**

Fax Entries, 1-336-272-0864 or 1-800-SHO-FAXS. Both sides of entry form must be transmitted. Entries must be accompanied by a cover sheet stating the number of pages, what shows and how many dogs per show. Visa/Mastercard/Discover/American Express number and expiration date, as well as the printed cardholder's name and address must be included on cover sheet and EACH entry form. Fax entries must be received by the closing hour/date. Fax fee: \$4.95 per entry in addition to entry fee. All credit card entries, regardless of method submitted, are processed through the Fax program and are charged the \$4.95 administrative fee. This Fax Fee is subject to change without notice.

Make All Checks and Money Orders payable to MB-F, Inc. CANADIAN/FOREIGN exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. When you provide a check as payment, you authorize us to either use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Superintendent assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Tabulate carefully. Due to cost of processing, no refunds \$5.00 and under will be made.

Post Dated Checks, Returned Checks and Declined Credit Cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or declined card. Subsequent returned checks or declined cards from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

CHARGEBACKS on Credit Cards are considered a violation of your agreement to pay the required entry fee for entry into a show and the AKC Compliance Dept. will be notified for their disciplinary action. Also, if this remains a bad debt, the club may decline future entries for their shows and the superintendent will decline future entries for ANY show submitted via any method of payment until the debt is paid (Chap. 11, Sec. 15, AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows). Thereafter, the superintendent will refuse all future credit card entries from the exhibitor. All future entries must be paid for in cash or by money order or check.

An AKC Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. **(There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)**

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline (877) 252-3229.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. **An Administrative Fee of \$5.00 will be charged or withheld from refunds for duplicate entries.**

An Administrative Fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Each Owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed & submitted the entry form.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring. **Class Cash Prizes** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendents and showing Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. For a detailed description of the National Owner-Handled Series, please visit the AKC website NOHS pages at:

Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

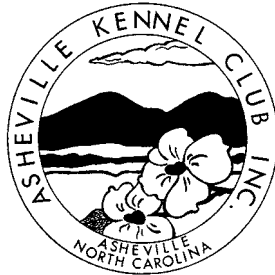

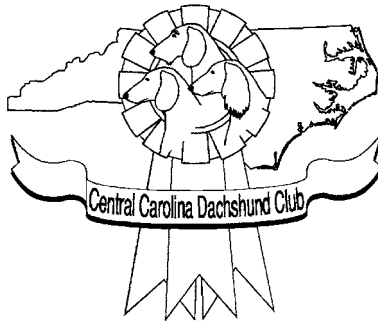

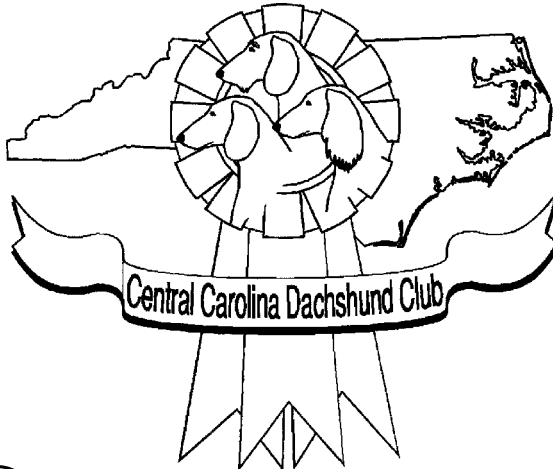
